Book, More Than Three Authors: add "et al" after author. "et al" is Latin meaning "and others.")

Book with an Editor, when citing entire book

OR (if collection of one author's work, edited by another person)

Book with an Editor, articles in the book/series have separate authors

Author. Title of the work (italicized if the work is independent, in quotation marks if part of a larger work). Title of the overall Website (if different from Title of the work). Publisher (if none, use N.p.) Date published (if none, use n.d.) Web. Date of access. Web address optional.
