

Scott M. Gibson, class of 1975, earned a Bachelor of Science Degree from Pennsylvania State University in 1980, a Master of Divinity Degree from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in 1983, a Master of Theology Degree from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1988, a Master of Theology Degree from Knox College in 1989, and a Doctor in Philosophy Degree from Regent's Park College in 1997.
