

Sherry A. Herrera, class of 1978, earned a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree from the University of Pittsburgh in 1983 and a Master of Science in Nursing Degree from the University of Texas in 1993.

Ms. Herrera began her career working in the Military Healthcare System since 1983. She spent the first 22 years as an active duty nurse in the United States Air Force working in a variety of settings including neonatal intensive care, inpatient and outpatient pediatrics, primary care, and multiple nurse executive positions in Air Force hospitals. As a neonatal intensive care nurse, Ms. Herrera was a member of an elite team that made medical history by performing heart lung bypass on an infant in-flight.
