Angelucci, Autumn Murphy was employed as a Long-term Secondary English Substitute for the first semester of the 2021-2022 school year with compensation awarded in the amount of \$23,852, representing step A of the negotiated contract for a non-tenured bachelor's degree by a unanimous roll call vote.
