Parking Registration and Safety Regulations

Driving to school is considered a privilege and the safety of all students, staff and visitors is our primary concern. If the regulations below are not followed, the privilege of driving to school may be suspended or revoked and vehicles can be towed at the owner's expense. We ask for your cooperation in keeping our parking lot and driveways safe for everyone.

- 1) All PA State traffic laws are to be followed at all times.
- 2) **Students are to park in parking lot left of the school. Students may only park in the "WHITE LINED" SPACES, Yellow spaces are for Staff and Rec Complex parking only.**
- 3) **Each student driver will pay a \$25.00 non-refundable parking fee.**
- 4) Parking tags must be used. They are to be properly displayed on the rear view mirror.
- 5) Upon arrival to school, vehicles should be parked in the appropriate lot and then vacated. Students should not loiter near or remain in their vehicles before, during or after school.
- 6) Conditions related with driving (car trouble, traffic, weather conditions) to school cannot be used as an excuse for being tardy.
- 7) Student drivers who are excessively TARDY may have the privilege of driving to school revoked.
- 8) Students are not permitted to return to their vehicle prior to dismissal for any reason.
- 9) Drivers using excessive speed, not adhering to stop signs and/or other reckless driving habits are creating unsafe conditions. Student driving and parking privileges can be revoked temporarily or permanently.
- 10) Students are to comply with the directions of the parking lot monitors and school security at all times.
- 11) New Parking Passes are distributed each school year, you may NOT use the same parking pass from year to year.
- 12) **As is outlined in the student handbook, if "reasonable suspicion" exists that a student may be in the possession of anything that is in violation of school rules and/or policies, local and/or state laws, or a potential threat to school safety, the school district reserves the right to search that student's vehicle and/or possessions while on school property. At any given time throughout the school year, trained police dogs will search the building and/or parking lot for illegal substances. If the dog indicates a vehicle may contain illegal substances that vehicle will be searched.**
