SUBJECT: Pennsylvania House of Representatives Scholarship Program

We have just received the updated materials for the 2023 PA House of Representatives Scholarship Program. The Program enhances educational opportunities for graduating high school seniors who reside in the Commonwealth of PA. The Program is administered through The Foundation for Enhancing Communities and provides four-year scholarships to two high school seniors per year. Each award consists of the value of one semester of tuition at the State System of Higher Education for each of four years. Students must maintain eligibility criteria in all four years in order to receive the ongoing award.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Graduating High School Senior
2. Legal Residency in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3. Attendance at a PA College, university, or career school as a full-time student
4. Academic achievement (minimum 3.0 cumulative high school GPA)
5. Commitment to community and leadership qualities
6. Extracurricular activities
7. Financial need

****Employees of the House, Legislators nor their dependents are eligible for the program***
