NOTICE TO SENIORS CLASS OF 2023

The legal issue selected for the Law Day 2023 Essay Contest is as follows:

Whether or not an individual state has the right to impose and implement their own immigration rules to limit the number of immigrants entering their state.

In order to qualify, the student must be a college bound member of the 2023 graduating class of a public high school located in Lawrence County. The essay submitted is to be typed, double spaced, limited to the topic selected, contain no fewer than 750 words and no more than 1,250 words. The submission must include the student's full name, address, telephone number and school represented on a **separate** cover sheet. **None of the identifying information should be on any page of the essay itself.** Relatives of members of the Lawrence County Bar Association cannot qualify. Submissions must include research providing citations and footnotes.

The contest allows for two winners. Each will be the recipient of a \$2,000.00 scholarship to be paid to the student's college, applicable to tuition and related expenses and fees (excluding room and board). The Annual Law Day Program is tentatively scheduled for Monday, May 1, 2023 in Courtroom # 1 of the Lawrence County Government Center where the scholarships will be presented. Winners will be notified by telephone the week of April 24th.

The deadline for submission is **Monday, April 10, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.**
