Interested Applicant of The New York Blower Corey Blake Memorial Scholarship Program:

The New York Blower Corey Blake Memorial Scholarship is a program offered to high school seniors and GED test completers who will be attending an approved/accredited community college or trade school in pursuit of a certificate or degree in drafting/designing, technical service/maintenance, welding, or machine tool operation. Applicants must be legal residents of the United States or eligible to legally work in the U.S., have a minimum 2.5 GPA and/or "C" and/or "Pass" grade, be a high school senior graduating in Spring of 2023, or have successfully completed the GED test, and be enrolled/starting at an approved/accredited community college or trade school before **October 1, 2023**.

Scholarship recipients will be required to sign a contract prior to completing the degree program within 4 years while maintaining a 2.5 GPA and/or "C" and/or "Pass" grades. Upon completion of the recipient's education, they would then continue working at NYB for 2 years or refund 50% of the scholarship amount to NYB. While attending school, the recipients will qualify for an entry-level position in the field where they are seeking a degree or certificate. The recipients will be required to work 32 hours per week in the facility, will be granted 8 hours of paid time to attend classes while they are in session, be willing to travel for a 2-week period to the different NYB facilities or to vendors for additional technical training with a max of 4 weeks of offsite training in a year period, and will be paid at the entry-level wage or salary for that position. When classes are not in session, recipients will be required to work at the facility(s) during normal hours. Recipients will fall under the standard NYB probation period after joining NYB.

Each scholarship is limited to a maximum of 65 credits and \$20,000 over the course of 4 years for tuition, school fees, and books. The actual amount will depend on the course/programs at that college/trade school for the degree program the recipient has chosen to take. Applications will be reviewed and those candidates who are selected from those applications will be brought in for a formal interview at NYB. Applications need to be submitted by the end of day **Friday, May 26, 2023**. Upon receipt of the application, applicants will receive a follow-up email confirming receipt of the application and what further steps will be taken regarding their application.
